#VancouverBulletinBoard is a unique three-dimensional painting that vibrantly captures an overhead view of the Point Grey neighbourhood and central Vancouver on a beautiful summer's day. The landmarks include: UBC with the Musqueam sports field logo, Spanish Banks, English Bay, H. R. MacMillan Space Centre, Burrard Street Bridge, Stanley Park, Lions Gate Bridge and North Shore mountains. The scene is bustling with cars, cyclists, buses, people enjoying the beach, sailboats, cruise ships, freighters and sea planes.

The 3D nature of the painting offers viewers the opportunity to engage with the art work from three different perspectives, giving the painting a “revolving billboard style” effect. Painted with acrylic paint on canvas and stretched over fifteen separate columns, these 6' x 6" x 3" panels work together to create a new and exciting way to view Vancouver from John's perspective.

Born and raised in Vancouver, John is an established artist whose paintings are immediately recognizable for their bright jewel-toned colours and whimsy. John is very familiar with the Point Grey community and has lovingly painted scenes of Vancouver for over 20 years. As much as this city has evolved and changed, the natural beauty of Vancouver remains the same; one of the most unique and exquisite waterways and ports in the world.
