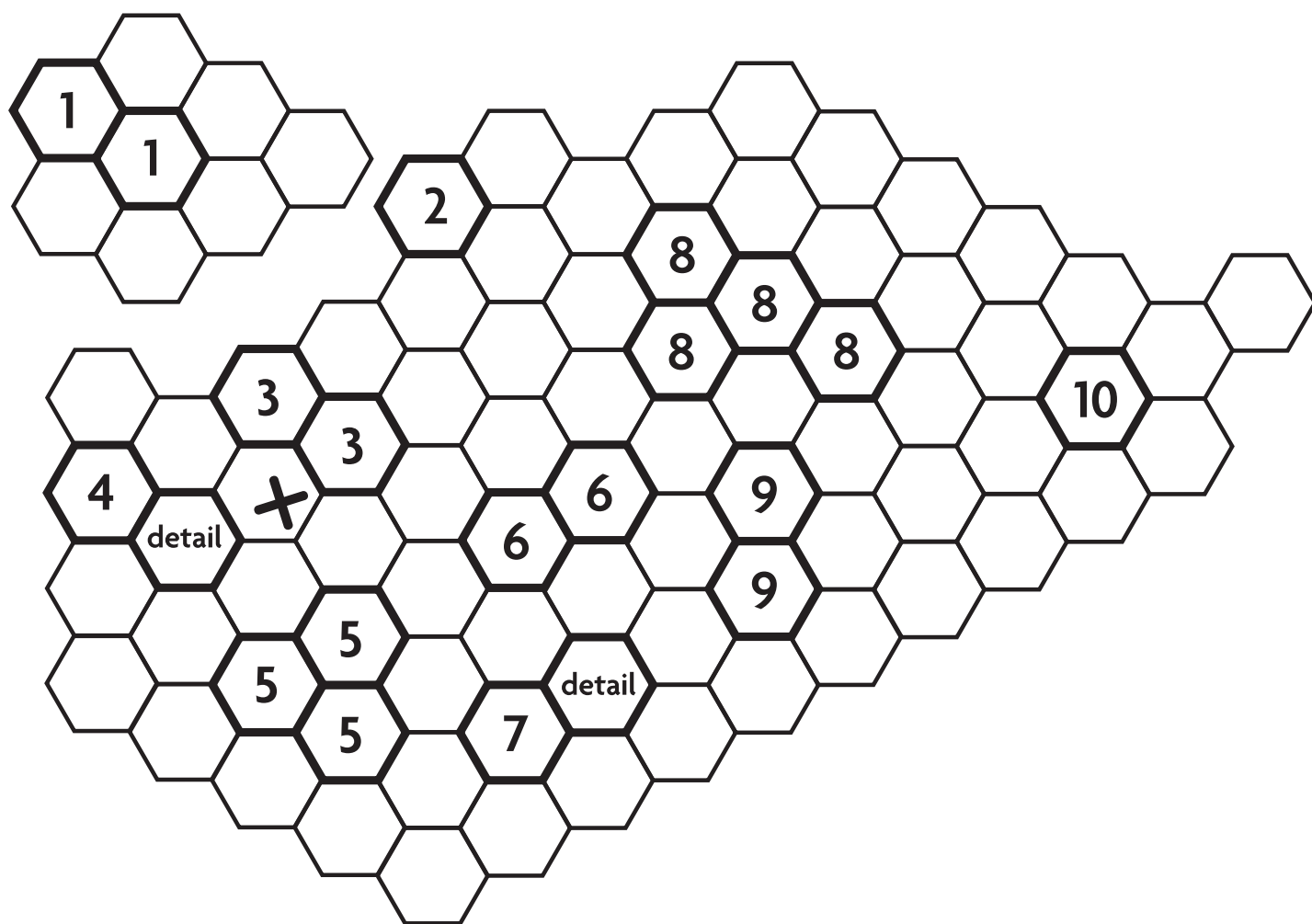


***RE-Mapping an Island*, 2014**

Composed into the abstracted form of Richmond, photos on ceramic tiles depict places and industries that tell of the city's heritage, growth and vibrant communities. Peeling back the layers of time and development, names sprout new significance as we imagine racetracks and canneries where shops and homes now stand. Photos were produced in blue and white, a ceramic tradition used by many cultures over the centuries.

The paper tiles are made entirely with recycled paper, including architectural drawings from this project and old Vancity brochures. Efforts in being environmentally conscious reflect Dear Human's creative practice and Vancity's commitment to the environment.
